

CITY OF LINCOLNSHIRE
ORDINANCE NO. 1, SERIES 2015

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO PARKING OR STORING OF MOTOR VEHICLES,
BOATS, CAMPERS, RECREATIONAL VEHICLES AND TRAILERS IN THE CITY OF
LINCOLNSHIRE.

WHEREAS, the City of Lincolnshire desires to amend Ordinance No. 8 Series 1992 regarding parking and enforcement.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF LINCOLNSHIRE, that Section 13 of Ordinance No. 8 Series 1992 is hereby amended to read as follows:

SECTION 13:

A. Any violation of this ordinance shall subject the offender to a civil penalty in an amount equal to the minimum fine prescribed by Section 12 of this ordinance. Such civil penalty may be recovered by the city in a civil action in the nature of a debt if the offender has been cited for the ordinance violation. The civil penalty may be used as an alternative to or in conjunction with the criminal penalties authorized in Section 12 of this ordinance.

B.

1) Any vehicle abandoned or illegally parked on the public ways may be removed at the direction of the Chief of Police or his or her designated agent to a tow lot designated by the city. The vehicle may be reclaimed by the owner at the owner's expense including all towing and storage charges and payment of all fines imposed by the city

2) The Chief of Police or his or her designated agent shall release a vehicle to its legal owner without fine if it has been determined by the city police that the vehicle was stolen.

3)

a.) Any vehicle remaining in the possession of the contracted tow lot to which it has been delivered and with which it has remained for a period of 60 days without being reclaimed by the rightful owner thereof, and without the payment of the towing and storage charges thereon, may after authorization of the Chief of Police or his or her designated agent, be sold to pay the towing and storage. The advertisement of the proposed sale shall be published as set forth in KRS 424.130. The last advertisement shall be made at least seven days before sale is held. Notice of sale shall be sent by registered mail to the owner of the motor vehicle, and to any other person known to have any interest therein, addressed to the person at their last known address at least ten days before the sale is held.

b.) The owner of any motor vehicle may sign a waiver of notice of sale and waiting period and permit the tow lot to sell the motor vehicle whenever he or she deems it proper and necessary.

4) No vehicle shall be released by the tow lot except on written order from the Chief of Police.

SECTION 2:

This ordinance shall become effective upon its adoption and publication as required by law.

This Ordinance shall take effect upon passage and publication as required by law.

Ordinance # 002 Series 2015

AN ORDINANCE LEVYING AN AD VALOREM TAX FOR 2015-2016 BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF LINCOLNSHIRE:


Section 1. - An ad valorem tax for the year 2015-2016 is hereby levied and fixed at the rate of 22 cents on each \$100.00 of all the real estate and personal property within the corporate limits of Lincolnshire as assessed for the taxation and subject to taxation by said City, under assessment as of January 1, 2015.

Section 2. - Said tax shall be due and payable on 11/01/2015 and payment shall be made to the City Treasurer. A discount of 5% of the face amount of the bill shall be allowed for the taxes paid on or before 10/01/2015. In the event any owner fails to pay tax assessed prior to 11/01/2015, there is hereby levied, as a penalty, an amount equal to 10% of the tax payable, plus interest from 11/01/2015 until paid, at the rate of 1.5% per month or part thereof, or \$10.00, if the penalty and interest is less than \$10.00.

Section 3. - The proceeds of such taxes, penalties, and interest are to be placed in the general fund of the City of Lincolnshire and are to be used for general operating purposes and expenses of the City, such as the purchase of City supplies, purchase and maintenance of City property, street repair, garbage collection, police protection, and all other necessary and proper municipal functions; as may be properly ordained or resolved by the City Commissioners.

Section 4. - This ordinance shall take effect from and after its passage, signing, and publication as required by law.

AN ORDINANCE LEVYING A SANITATION FEE FOR FISCAL YEAR JULY 1, 2015 THROUGH AND INCLUDING JUNE 30, 2016; PROVIDING PAYMENT OF SAME AND THE SENDING OF BILLS.
BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF LINCOLNSHIRE:

Section 1. - A \$70.00 fee for each resident due 11/01/2015

Section 2. - The levied Sanitation Fee herein shall be due and payable as follows:

Bills paid on or before 10/01/2015:

5% Discount

Bills paid on 10/02/2015 through 10/31/2015:

Face amount of bill


Bills paid on or after 11/01/2015:

10% penalty plus interest from 11/01/2015 until paid at the rate of 1.5% per month or part thereof, or \$6.00 if the penalty and interest is less than \$6.00.

Section 3. - The proceeds of such taxes, penalties, and interest are to be placed in the general fund of the City of Lincolnshire and are to be used for general operating purposes and expenses of the City, such as the purchase of City supplies, purchase and maintenance of City property, street repair, garbage collection, police protection, and all other necessary and proper municipal functions; as may be properly ordained or resolved by the City Commissioners.

Section 4. - This ordinance shall take effect from and after its passage, signing, and publication as required by law.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF LINCOLNSHIRE SECTION 1:
