A regular meeting of the Board of Commissioners was held on November 13, 2018 at the Louisville East Nursing Home. Those in attendance were:

The meeting was called to order at 7:00pm. The October meeting minutes were reviewed. Commissioner Duncan raised a motion to accept the minutes, Commissioner Thomas seconded the motion, and the motion passed.

Police Report

Chief Watson reported there have been no significant police issues in the City recently. A state grant check for the police department in the amount of \$1,229 was recently received. Chief Watson patrolled the neighborhood and gave out candy on Halloween.

Sanitation Report

Commissioner Peter advised there have been no sanitation issues reported within the city of Lincolnshire.

Treasury Report

Accounting reports for the 4 months of the fiscal year to date (7/1/2018 – 10/31/2018) and a list of receipts/disbursements for the month of October were reviewed by the Commissioners. Commissioner Peter raised a motion to accept the budget, Commissioner Steurer seconded the motion, and the motion passed.

Old Business

Mayor Hudson reported that trees and brush are being removed at the rear of 8 Pembroke Road. Commissioner Thomas is continuing to evaluate improvements and financial options for the Lincolnshire Police Department. There was no other old business to review.

New Business

The board discussed the possibility of speed humps to help control traffic speeds in the city, primarily on Pembroke and Edmonia and near the intersection of Canterbury and Pembroke. Chief Watson will develop recommendations for the number and locations of speed humps so that costs can be evaluated.
